Dear Parents

Education aims at making children capable of becoming responsible mandatory, productive and useful members of society. Knowledge skills and attitudes are built through learning experiences and opportunities created for learners in school. It is in the classroom that learners can analyze and evaluate their experiences, learn to doubt, to question to investigate and to think independently.

As you are aware that CBSE has introduced CCE pattern it means regularity of assessment, frequency of unit testing, diagnosis of learning gaps, use of corrective measures, retesting and feedback of evidence to teachers and students for their self evaluation. The scheme emphasis to develop holistic learning.

The comprehensive component of CCE include Scholastic: Subject specific areas and Co-Scholastic: Life skills, Attitudes and Values and other Co-Curricular activities for child growth.

COMPREHENSIVE AREA OF ASSESSMENT

Scholastic Areas (Compulsory for all)

PART – 1A – Academics Subjects: English, Mathematics, Social Science, Science, Hindi-A/Sanskrit & an optional additional subject Hindi Course B/ I.T (anyone).

(iii) Towards school programs (iv) Towards environment (v) Value System**

**PART - 3A – (Compulsory for all) (i) Scientific Skill (ii) Aesthetic Skill & Performing Art
(iii) Literary & Creative Skill**

PART 3B- (i) Sports (Compulsory for all)

PART 3B- (any one from the other two) (ii) First Aid / (iii) Yoga

Points to be noted:

(i) Academic Year will have to terms

I Term - April - September

II Term - October - March

(ii) Each term have two Formative Assessments and one Summative Assessment in each subject.

Term I FA –I FA-II SA-I

Term II FA-III FA-IV SA-II

Each Formative Assessment is further divided into smaller assessments (class work, home work, oral, quizzes, projects / assignments, pen paper tests etc) that combine to form the Final Grade of each formative.

Each Summative Assessment will be **Term End Pen-Paper Examination.**

(iii) For Class IX & X the curriculum and syllabus is as circulated by the board and Question Papers will be sent by the CBSE. There shall be no Board Examination at secondary level for students studying in the school affiliated to the board up to Senior Secondary level and who do not wish to move out of the CBSE system after class X. Exams will be conducted by school and evaluation of answer scripts will be done within the school.

(iv) Students of Senior Secondary Schools who wish to move out of the CBSE system after class X for admission to Pre-University, Vocational course, Change of Board etc shall be required to take the examination conducted by the board at Secondary (Class X) level.

(vi) The students will be assessed in subjects under Scholastic Area-A using the conventional numerical marking and later converted into grades. Subjects of study under Scholastic Area-A shall be assessed jointly by the school and the Board.

Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) would also be reflected in the statement of subject wise Performance.

(vii) The CBSE will issue a statement of subject wise performance i.e. grade sheet (no marks) for class X. The board will award Merit Certificates to such candidates who have obtained Grade A1 in all the five subjects under Scholastic Area-A at the Secondary School Examination. The CCE card will apply though out the CBSE School for admission to class XI.

(viii) Assessment in the subjects under Scholastic Area-B and Co-Scholastic Area shall be undertaken by the schools in terms of grades. The evaluation shall be based on the cumulative record of the candidate during his/her continuous assessment in the school.

(ix) Students will be only promoted on the basis of both Formative and Summative Assessment both of which are mandatory. It is mandatory to all the students to appear for all Formative Assessments.

(x) He / She must obtain D or above D grade in Formative Assessment to be allowed to appear in Summative Assessment.

(xi) The syllabus prescribed at secondary level is of two years integrated course, therefore the combined result of class IX and X will be declared by CBSE Board at the completion of two years.
